The Centre provides assistance to people in order to successfully maximize their chances to obtain employment.

Athens Solidarity Center

Athens Solidarity Centre offers use of space to new and existing civil society organizations in Greece. An initiative of the Open Society Foundations and Solidarity Now, in partnership with the Municipality of Athens and the financial support of the European Economic Area Grants, the Athens Solidarity Center opened its doors in December 2014.

The Centre is located on the 2nd floor of the Garrison historic building in Athens, the use of which was granted for this purpose to Solidarity Now by the Municipality of Athens for this purpose. The Centre's premises have been fully renovated and restored by Solidarity Now.

The Centre is open to all regardless of nationality, origins and social status and cooperates with four Greek NGO: ARSIS, PRAKSIS, Network for Children's Rights and Together for Children, offering its services to all in need. The services provided at the Solidarity Centre include health, legal aid, job-seeking assistance, and support for vulnerable groups including the elderly, the sick, migrants, and asylum seekers.
